Seneca Waterways Council Camps operate under permits issued by New York State Department of Health. Governor Cuomo’s Executive Order #202 was issued in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency, and this has modified requirements that are normally issued by the Department of Health to attend a Children’s camp.

We are required to obtain from all camp participants (youth and adults) a verification of the items listed below. This is in addition to the BSA Annual Health & Medical form for adults & youth and the NYS required Over-the-Counter medication form for youth.

You must meet one of the three requirements listed below to attend summer camp:
